Purpose

To comply with all current Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) Public Health Measures and recommendations, all attendees at all Saskatchewan Dodgeball events/tournaments must be fully vaccinated or provide a negative COVID test upon entry.

Policy

A proof of vaccination or negative test requirement will apply to all Saskatchewan Dodgeball events/tournaments.

All attendees must be fully vaccinated or provide a negative COVID Test to enter the facility.

Fully Vaccinated

Fully vaccinated means 14-days after receiving:

- the recommended number of doses of a COVID-19 vaccine, or combination of COVID-19 vaccines, approved by Health Canada; and
- 14 or more days have passed since the individual received the last of the recommended number of doses.

The following are acceptable forms of proof:

- A wallet card received at the time of immunization or
- a printed copy of a MySaskHealthRecord vaccine certificate, with or without a QR code or
- A screenshot of a MySaskHealthRecord vaccine certificate, with or without a QR code;
- A COVID-19 vaccine printout from Saskatchewan Health Authority, Public Health;
- A QR code/MySaskHealthRecord vaccine certificate uploaded to SK Vax Wallet;

Negative Test

Individuals who do not have proof of vaccination must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test conducted by a Saskatchewan Health Authority approved organization within 72 hours of event commencement.

The following are acceptable forms of proof:

- test results from a rapid antigen or
- test results from a polymerase chain reaction (PCR).

This test is to be completed at the expense of the individual.

Self-administered take-home rapid antigen tests (i.e. pictures of negative tests) will not be accepted.

Personal Identification

The following are acceptable forms of proof:

- A driver's licence issued by a government of a province or territory of Canada and including a photograph of the holder;
- A government (Saskatchewan or other) issued identification card, including health card; a birth certificate, or a copy of a birth certificate, issued by a government of a province or territory of Canada;
- A certificate of Indian Status; A Metis Nation Saskatchewan citizenship and identification card;
- A passport attesting to citizenship or other national status, issued by a government of any jurisdiction, that includes a photograph of the holder;
- A permanent resident or citizenship card;
- Or any other form of identification, issued by a government of any jurisdiction, that includes a photograph of the holder.
- A type of proof, whether electronic or in writing, that is issued by the government of Canada or a province or territory of Canada, or by any other government of another jurisdiction.

Masking

Masking is facility dependent and may be required. Saskatchewan Dodgeball will advertise if masking is optional or mandatory. The Saskatchewan Health Authority and/or Facility may change these requirements at any time. Saskatchewan Dodgeball will follow the stricter requirement.

Process

Proof of Vaccination/Negative test will only need to be provided once per event.

To minimize the access of personal health information and adhere to the Health Information Privacy Act (HIPA), only the minimal amount of information will be recorded by a select number of designative representatives. This information will be temporarily stored until the event is complete and the information is no longer required.

At the commencement of an event, designated representatives will be visually observing personal identification and vaccination/negative COVID test proof. If the information needs to be documented, only the following information will be recorded:

- Attendee First & Last Name
- Confirmation proof has been shown and the attendee is "cleared for entry"

No electronic copies will be retained/permitted.
